
# Universal Lightbar PNFWBMESU01



### INSTALLATION (cont.):

- 5. For the universal sliding plate, you will need to determine how it would be best positioned to match the curve of the windshield. The sliding plate can be flipped or/and rotated to give four different shapes. Find the curve that best fits your vehicle.
- 6. When the best curve and position is found, remove the liner on one side of the VHB tape. Apply the tape to the side of the sliding plate that is going to contact the shroud, ensuring the tape is positioned to where it will be completely sandwiched between the plate and shroud (See Fig. 2.)
- 7. On a flat surface, apply firm, even pressure to the adhesive tape. Using a roller would work best. Allow the adhesive tape to sit for at least 5 minutes for proper adhesion.
- 8. After the five minutes of cure time has elapsed, peel off the remaining tape liner and mate the sliding plate to the shroud. To ensure proper positioning, slowly move the sliding plate up the edge of the windshield in the desired orientation until the adhesive contacts the shroud.
- 9. Remove the shroud assembly and place it on a flat surface so that firm even pressure can once again be applied to ensure the adhesive is properly wetted out. Allow to cure for five minutes.
- 10. Apply the rubber gasket to the shroud/sliding plate edge that will touch off on the windshield. There might be a transition period where the rubber gasket surrounds just the sliding plate, or the sliding plate and the shroud.
- 11. Loosely, reinstall the shroud assembly. Slight adjustments may be necessary in the mounting brackets to ensure best fit to the windshield, depending on how the install went. After the fit is ideal, tighten down all bolts and the sun visor mounting screws.
