


nFORCE LED Interior Lightbar 2018-2021 JEEP WRANGLER



△WARNING

- HIGH CURRENT interconnects must be properly terminated. Poor crimp quality can cause heat build-up and fire. Follow crimp connector manufacturer instructions.
- DO NOT install this product or route any wires in the Air Bag Deployment Zone. Refer to vehicle Owner's Manual for deployment zones.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Unlatch and open the soft top or remove hard top panels.
- 2. Remove the hardware using a T-40 Torx socket and loosely install the supplied brackets.

NOTE: The bracket is not symmetric. The slots on the brackets are 2 different sizes. The larger holes must be used on the top.

- 3. Tilt the lightbar into place, careful not to knock off the smaller end gaskets.
- 4. Loosely attach the lightbar to the brackets using the supplied T-40 Torx bolts and washers.
- 5. After completing the wire routing, push the light brackets forward until they rest against the plastic trim.
- Tighten the factory T-40 screws, some adjustments may be necessary to re-align the brackets to your top latches.
- 7. Push up on the light bar and tighten the T-40 screws from bracket to the lightbar.

NOTE: Do NOT exceed 25 ft. lbs of torque.
